What's In It for Me?

Oft times when a member of the Executive mentions joining the RCMP Veterans' Association (**RCMPVA**), valid questions such as, "Why?" or, "What's in it for Me?" are asked. Good questions deserve even better answers.

The RCMPVA works with the RCMP and the **National Police Federation (NPF)** to build a transition process from the last day of our service to the golden years of retirement.

Why join the RCMPVA is as simple as our **A, B, C's**.

Advocacy: The RCMPVA is the only formalized entity to provide support, guidance, and advocate for our veterans and families as we deal with the challenges of life after the RCMP. Joining the Association provides strength in numbers from sea to sea to sea. As a member of the Association, you receive access to the members' only part of the RCMPVA website.

Benefits: As the legal entity of record, the RCMPVA administers applications and ongoing management of applications

for access to emergency funds from the Benefit Trust Fund (BTF). While the emergency support remains confidential, the benefits remain real. Assistance with pension, medical, and dental claim coverage is another benefit.

Camaraderie: We are more than a Koffee Klatch, but there is nothing wrong with the camaraderie regular coffee sessions provide. Our network of support is obvious during face-to-face interactions at coffee, lunch, and dinner events. Membership provides as little or as much support as needed as we transition together.
