

I have some additional information, which may help you. I belong to the National Association of Federal Retirees. They publish a magazine called Sage. I just received the latest edition, which includes an article *Canada Life is Coming*. Here is a portion of the article;

**2. Give your pharmacy your new Canada Life information:** With Canada Life, the PSHCP policy number (55555 with Sun Life) will change, but your individual certificate number will remain the same. Update your pharmacy file by July 1, 2023. The enrolment package contains your new PSHCP plan number, which will be determined by the month of birth or member status.

I also obtained the following information from another document;

Your certificate number will remain the same, however, your plan number will change. Your new plan number is based on your month of birth:

- (52111) January, February, March
- (52112) April, May, June
- (52113) July, August, September
- (52114) October, November, December
- The plan number will be 52115 for eligible and surviving dependants (spouse or eligible children)
