The 2023 AGM was held in Ottawa. Warren Gherasim attended on our Division's behalf and his comments are attached.

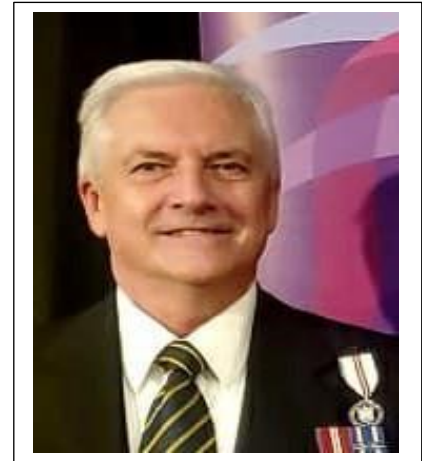
The August Annual Golf tournament (and our summer BBQ Social) are on August 23rd and I encourage those inclined to swing into this one as spots are filling up.

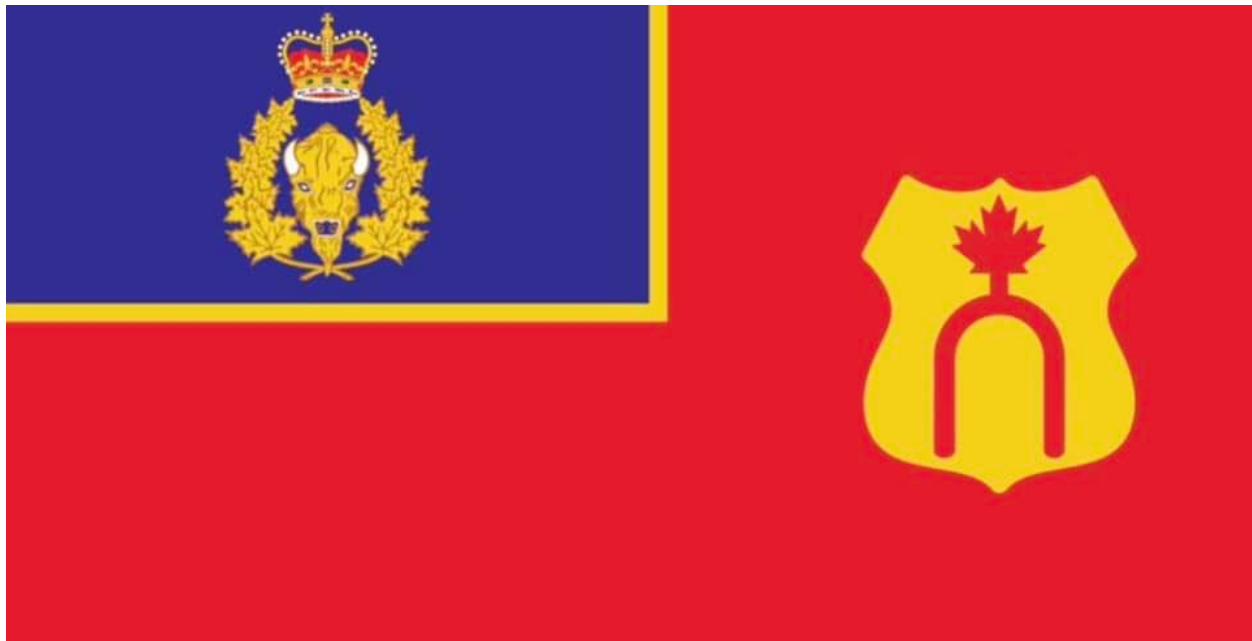

Gravesite Inspection Project

The process of graves site inspections for our Vets division got underway on May 17th. Inspections are underway with no concerns raised to this point. To date (June 27), eight inspection reports have been submitted. The Regina Vets held a zoom meeting on June 20th and kicked off their inspection process. Below is the communique which went out to the Detachments on June 20th from "F" Division Comms:

RCMP Veterans' Association conducting grave inspections throughout Saskatchewan

June 20, 2023

The RCMP Regina and Saskatoon Veteran's Association have partnered with F Division to assist with annual grave inspections and maintenance where possible.

This joint initiative was launched as a part of the RCMP150.

Detachment Commanders: Please be aware that this incentive has been reviewed and approved by the Commanding Officer "F" Division.

The Veterans have permission to conduct the inspections and perform basic maintenance (e.g. cleaning grave site of long grass/weeds, basic cleaning of headstone/markers).

The Veteran Associations will be completing an annual report to the respective District Commanders of their findings.

RCMP grave inspections are scheduled annually. Detachment Commanders are to ensure that graves within their Detachment areas are inspected and maintained.

Any cost of repairing or replacing a Regimental Marker are the responsibility of the Force as defined in NCM-ch. 2.2. Compensation for Civilian Members, Commissioned Officers, and Civilian Officer Equivalents – Infoweb (rcmp-grc.gc.ca)

A list of searchable list of Force burials in Saskatchewan is maintained by Regina / Saskatoon Veteran's Association to assist in identifying graves in your detachment area. This list is not to be distributed further without the permission of the Regina or Saskatoon Veteran's Association.

Effective July 1st, 2023, Canada Life will become our new Public Service Health Care Plan administrator. At the beginning of April 2023, many of us received an email from Canada Life with a requirement to complete a "positive enrolment" application in order for our personal information to be registered with Canada Life. **Our members should be reminded there was a deadline (June 30th, 2023), once this email is received requiring the completion of a 'positive enrollment link'.** In completing this application process some members encountered problems with the Canada Life database only recognizing three letters of their name, and direction to contact our Pension Centre if there is a significant problem. It was on July 7, 2006, 17 years ago, that members of the Spiritwood Detachment responded to a complaint of an assault which had occurred near their detachment in Spiritwood. The suspect was identified to them and upon their attendance a chase ensued as they attempted to apprehend the suspect, a local man operating a pickup truck. The chase lasted approximately 27 kilometres and ended near the community of Midred, Saskatchewan. There was a collision between at least one of the police vehicles and the suspect's truck.

The suspect emerged from his vehicle and opened fire on the three RCMP officers. Two officers were shot through their windshield, with bullets striking them in the head. The third officer was hit with shrapnel and wounded. Constable Robin Cameron succumbed to her wound on July 15, Constable Marc Bourdages died the following day on July 16.

A manhunt for the suspect ensued and twelve days later he surrendered to police on July 18. He was charged with two counts of first-degree murder and one count of attempted murder. He was convicted in 2009 and received a life sentence with parole eligibility set at 25 years.

The third officer survived and she was later awarded the Medal of Bravery.

Constable Robin Cameron was 29 years old and from the Beardys First Nation. Constable Marc Bourdages was 26 years old and was from Quebec.

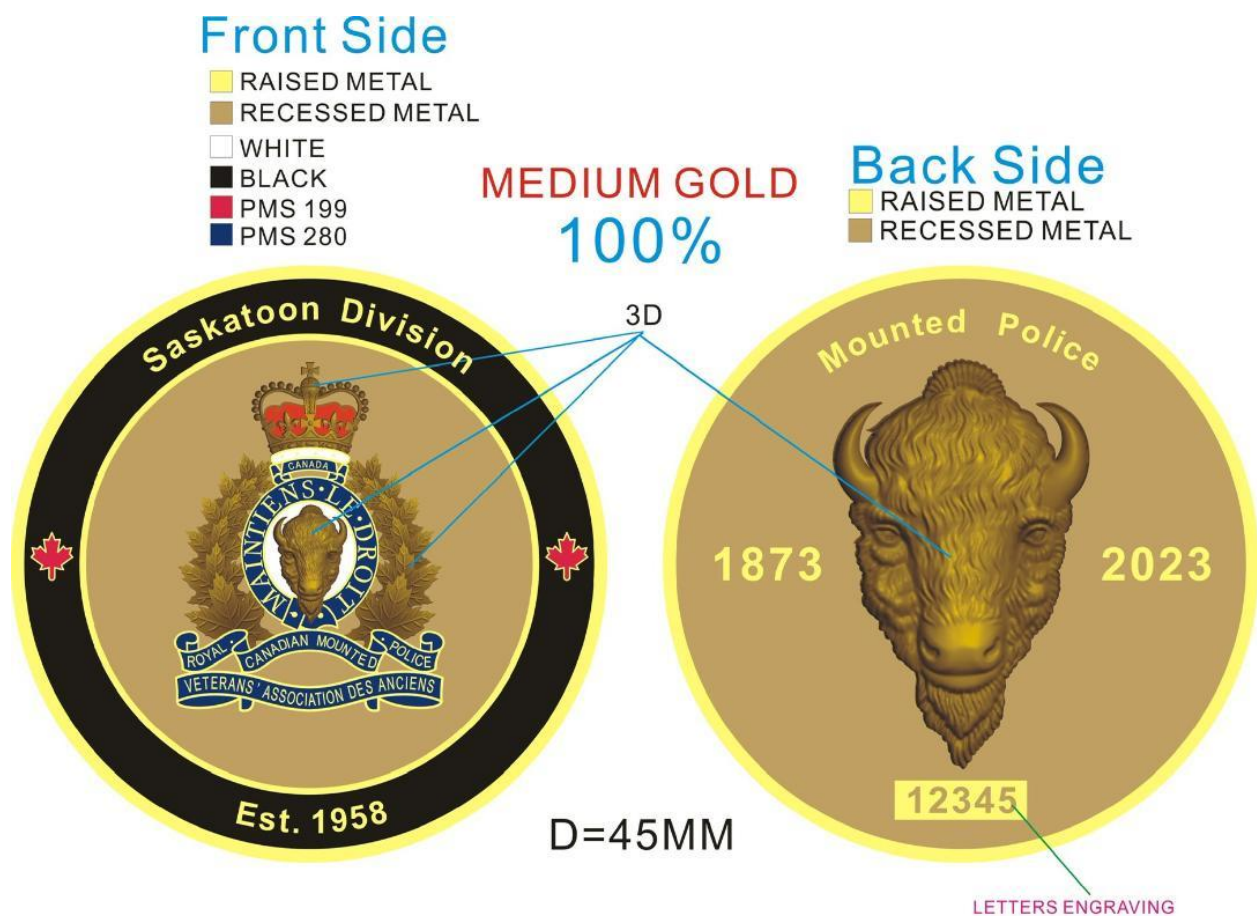
