The Emergency Services Personnel Funeral Program

This benefit provides dignified and honourable services/tributes, at no cost, for career and volunteer emergency service personnel who fall in the line of duty and also includes benefits for his/her immediate family as well as those of his/her spouse.



Line of Duty Benefits Include:

Active, Retired and Immediate Family Benefits:
