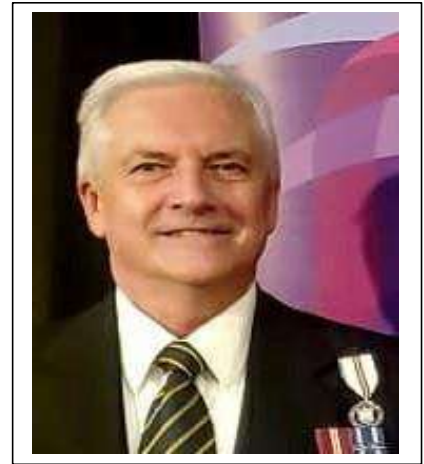

Canada Life - New Public Services Health Care Provider:

Affective July 1st, 2023, Canada Life will become our new Pubic Service Health Care Plan administrator. At the beginning of April 2023, many of us received an email from Canada Life with a requirement to complete a "positive enrolment" application in order for our personal information to be registered with Canada Life. **Our members should be reminded there was a deadline (June 30th, 2023), once this email is received requiring the completion of a 'positive enrollment link'.**

In completing this application process some members encountered problems with the Canada Life database only recognizing three letters of their name, and direction to contact our Pension

We are now into our 4th month of the transition with coverage via Canada Life. You are not alone if you have experienced frustration with the service. Know that progress is slow but progress continues.

The following may assist you with questions that occur:

1. Life Insurance: Those of you who retained the basic life insurance to and past the age of 70 will see your \$12 or so monthly premium payments start up again in early 2024.
2. Web based services are here to stay. Many websites are out there to guide us in our retirement journey. The named websites within this newsletter remain up to date.

3. Anecdotal information from those of us who actually telephoned and spoke to a live Canada Life representative is that the person on the other end knew what they were talking about. Suggestion: Have your identification readily accessible and be ready to roll with your specific questions.
4. Communication: “What do we actually receive for our membership within the RCMP Veterans?” I am on a National short term task force to identify the best methods to keep our membership abreast of what it costs to keep this, Not for Profit Association legally compliant with legislation. Stay tuned for further news and views.
5. “Why did you join the Association?” Please think about your motivations during our current renewal period. What can you do to make the Association more effective? Your Saskatoon Executive are volunteers and we do need your help to provide meaningful assistance to our members.
