Pension Disability Class Action Order - President & Secretary

Latest from Disabled Veterans Class Action website:

We are pleased to inform you that the Federal Court has approved the settlement of this class proceeding. The Court's Order will not become effective until March 18, 2024. Later this year, Class Members who currently receive disability pensions directly from Veterans Affairs

Canada (VAC) will automatically receive settlement payments from VAC by direct deposit or cheque. Estates and other Class Members and survivors who do not currently receive disability pensions directly from VAC will be required to file a Claim Form: Claim Forms may be filed with the settlement administrator beginning on March 18, 2024 (up to 9 months to claim). We will post more information about the claims process at that time. A copy of the Federal Court decision approving the settlement is now posted on this site at: Order and Reasons for Settlement Approval

The quick calculation of the entitlement for current recipients is:

Total of all VA disability pension payments since 2002 multiplied by .02 (2%)

All members are encouraged to identify and help survivors in preparing a claim form and accessing their entitlements under this order.
